

ORDINANCE No. 2009- 15

AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE TO APPROVE A CONSTRUCTION AGREEMENT FOR WATER SYSTEM IMPROVEMENTS, TOWN OF OPHIR, COLORADO

WHEREAS, the Town of Ophir has received loan funding from the Colorado Water Resource and Power Development Authority, and grant funding from the Colorado Department of Local Affairs, for the purpose of construction of water system improvements; and

WHEREAS, a condition of such grant and loan funding is to initiate construction of the water system improvements before the end of calendar year 2009; and

WHEREAS, Town of Ophir has received bids from water system improvement work and is prepared to award the construction contract for water system improvements to Reams Construction Co., the lowest qualified bidder; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to authorize approval of said construction contract at the Ophir General Assembly December 15, 2009 meeting, in order that the contract or may initiate construction work before the end of calendar year 2009.

NOW, THEREFOR, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE TOWN OF OPHIR, COLORADO that:

1. The Town Mayor, Town Manager and Town Clerk are hereby authorized and directed to execute a construction contract with Reams Construction Co., in the amount not to exceed \$772,637.56 for the work summarized on Schedule A of the Town of Ophir, Colorado bid tabulation dated December 11, 2009, and consisting generally of treatment plant construction, storage tank construction, infiltration gallery and pipeline improvements. The form of the construction contract and related documents including General Conditions, are contained in Bid Documents and Addenda and are on file with the Town Manager.

2. The passage of this Ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the health, safety and welfare of the Town of Ophir and its residents.
