TOWN OF OPHIR RESOLUTION 2001-

A RESOLUTION SUMMARIZING EXPENDITURES AND REVENUES FOR EACH FUND, APPROVING A MILL LEVY AND ADOPTING A BUDGET FOR THE TOWN OF OPHIR, COLORADO, FOR THE CALENDAR YEAR BEGINNING ON THE FIRST DAY OF JANUARY, 2002 AND ENDING ON THE LAST DAY OF DECEMBER, 2002.

WHEREAS, the General Assembly of the Town of Ophir elected Treasurer Robyn Laub, has prepared and submitted a proposed budget for the 2002 calendar year to the Ophir General Assembly; and

WHEREAS, Robyn Laub, elected Treasurer for the Town of Ophir has submitted a proposed budget to the General Assembly for its consideration; and

WHEREAS, upon due and proper notice, published and posted in accordance with the law, said proposed budget was open for inspection by the public at a public hearing held November 20, 2001 and interested taxpayers were given the opportunity to object to said proposed budget; and

WHEREAS, whatever increases may have been made in the expenditures, like increases were added to the revenues so that the budget remains in balance, as required by law.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE TOWN OF OPHIR, COLORADO:
