

Resolution No. 2008- 4
TOWN OF OPHIR

**DESIGNATING A PORTION OF OPHIR PASS ROAD AS A SEASONAL FOUR
WHEEL DRIVE ROAD FOR MAINTENANCE PURPOSES**

WHEREAS, the General Assembly of the Town of Ophir has annexed the Ferric Oxide Placer, MS 1661, Iron Springs Mining District, San Miguel County, Colorado, ("Ferric Oxide Placer") by enacting Ordinance No. ~~2008-2~~; and


WHEREAS, the General Assembly of the Town of Ophir finds that the acquisition of the Ferric Oxide Placer by the Town of Ophir was for open space preservation purposes and that no development is planned or intended; and,

WHEREAS, the General Assembly finds that maintaining the portion of the Ophir Pass road that crosses the Ferric Oxide Placer as a seasonal four wheel drive road will promote the health, safety and general welfare of the Ophir community;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE TOWN OF OPHIR, that:

SECTION 1. Designation of Road Across Ferric Oxide Placer. The General Assembly hereby designates the portion of the Ophir Pass Road as it crosses the Ferric Oxide Placer Claim as a seasonal four wheel drive road and that such road shall only be maintained by the Town of Ophir to a level which permits four wheel drive passage during the non-winter months and maintains the road in a rough and present state. The General Assembly further resolves that the Town of Ophir shall not provide any winter maintenance or snow removal for the portion of the Ophir Pass Road on the Ferric Oxide Placer claim.
