An ordinance establishing tap fees and monthly water service charges.

Be it ordered by the Town of Ophir, Colorado:

1. Each residential and/ or commercial unit within the Town of Ophir shall have a tap onto the town water system.
2. Each residence or dwelling shall before being occupied, be tapped onto the water system. It shall be unlawful to occupy a residence or a dwelling without being tapped onto the water system.
3. Water taps shall be charged at the rate of \$500.00 per tap, and said tap fee shall be payable upon issuance of a building permit.
4. Monthly water charges shall be at the rate of \$5.00 per month.
5. If a water line is required to be extended before a tap can be accomplished then subsequent users of said extended line shall be liable for the proportional cost of the installation of the extention. The Town of Ophir shall act as the collection agent for the payment of the extended service. This cost shall be in addition to the tap fee.
6. The water commissioner shall give approval to any extention and no extention shall be made until the commissioner has the route of the line, line size and other specifications. The Town Board shall have final review over the water commissioner.
7. Violations of this ordinance shall be punishable by fine of not more than \$300.00 or imprisonment for a period not to exceed 5 days or both such fine or imprisonment. Each day of violation shall constitute a separate offense.
