OPHIR COLORADO

AN ORDINANCE REQUIRING VOTERS TO REGISTER WITH THE TOWN CLERK

WHEREAS, it is in the interest of the General Assembly to accurately determine the number of qualified voters in the Town of Ophir for legislative purposes,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE TOWN OF OPHIR THAT THE FOLLOWING VOTER REGISTRATION REQUIREMENTS AND QUALIFICATIONS ARE HEREBY ADOPTED:

To qualify to vote, an individual must have resided in Ophir for at least the 30 days prior to a meeting, must be at least 18 years of age, and must be properly registered to vote in San Miguel County as a resident of the Town of Ophir, Colorado.

An individual is disqualified if he/she has not voted in the

previous 12 months.
