AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE TOWN TO PROVIDE FREE WATER SERVICE TO MEMBERS IN GOOD STANDING OF THE TELLURIDE VLUNTEER FIRE DEPARTMENT.

WHEREAS, the Telluride Volunteer Fire Department provides an important service the Town of Ophir; and

WHEREAS, the Volunteer Firepersons receive no compensation for this service.

That all Members in Good Standing of the Telluride Volunteer Fire Department who have been members for a period of not less than one year, shall receive no water charges from the Town of Ophir as long as they remain members of the organization.
