

AN ORDINANCE FOR THE REGULATION OF TRAFFIC BY THE TOWN OF OPHIR, COLORADO, FOR THE PURPOSE OF PROVIDING A SYSTEM OF TRAFFIC REGULATIONS CONSISTANT WITH STATE LAW; ADOPTING BY REFERENCE THE 1977 EDITION OF THE "MODEL TRAFFIC CODE FOR COLORADO MUNICIPALITIES", AND PROVIDING FOR PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION THEREOF

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the General Assembly, Town of Ophir, Colorado:

#### Section 1. Adoption

Pursuant to Title 31, Article 16, Part II, C.R.S. 1973, as amended, there is hereby adopted by reference the "Model Traffic Code for Colorado Municipalities" officially approved, adopted and published in 1977 as such by the State Dept. of Highways, Denver, Colorado, a copy of which is on file with the Town Clerk of Ophir, Oohir, Co., and may be inspected during regular business hours, the same being adopted as if set out at length.

#### Section 2. Penalties

The following penalties, herewith set forth in full, shall apply to this ordinance:

- a. It is unlawful for any person to violate any of the provisions stated or adopted in this ordinance.
- b. Every person convicted of a violation of any provision stated or adopted in this ordinance shall be punished by a fine not exceeding three hundred dollars (\$300.00), or by imprisonment not exceeding ninety (90) days, or both such fine and imprisonment.

#### Section 3. Application

This ordinance shall apply to every street, ally, sidewalkarea, driveway, park, and to every other public way or public parking area, either within or outside the corporate limits of this municipality, the use of which this municipality has jurisdiction and authority to regulate.

#### Section 4. Validity

If any part or parts of this ordinance are for any reason held to be invalid, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this ordinance.

#### Section 5. Repeal

Existing ordinances or parts of ordinances covering the same matters as embraced in this ordinance are hereby repealed, and all ordinances or parts or ordinances inconsistant with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

#### Section 6. Interpretation

This ordinance shall be so interpreted and construed as to effectuate its general purpose to make uniform the local traffic regulations contained herein. Article and section headings of the ordinance and Model Traffic Code as adopted shall not be deemed to govern, limit, modify or in any manner affect the scope, meaning or extent of the provisions of any article or sections hereof.

Introduced, read, passed and published after 2 public hearings by the General Assembly of the Town of Ophir.
