

Town of Ophir Ordinance no. 82-1

An Ordinance authorizing certain appropriations for the fiscal year 1983

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE TOWN OF OPHIR,
COLORADO THAT THE FOLLOWING MONIES WILL BE APPROPRIATED FOR THE FISCAL YEAR
1983:

1. From the general fund, the sum of \$4880 shall be appropriated, as reflected by the attached itemized Budget.
2. All Real Estate Transfer tax monies collected to date, and real estate transfer monies to be collected during 1983 shall be set aside in a fund to be used to retire the Town of Ophir's debt on the water line. The General Assembly may, if it deems it necessary, authorize the town manager to use those funds for other specific purposes, if an amount equal to the 1983 water line payment is left in the fund.
3. All horse use fees shall be used to purchase needed supplies for town hall.
4. Revenue Sharing funds shall be appropriated by the General Assembly for specific projects benefiting the town's citizens.
5. Rental income shall be used as the General Assembly deems necessary.
6. Any additional income received by the Town of Ophir shall be appropriated on an as-needed basis.
