

TOWN OF OPHIR ORDINANCE 84-2

An Ordinance authorizing certain appropriations for the fiscal year 1985

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY, TOWN OF OPHIR, STATE OF COLORADO THAT THE FOLLOWING MONIES WILL BE APPROPRIATED FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 1985:

1. From the General Fund, the sum of \$6521 shall be appropriated, as reflected by the attached itemized budget.
2. All monies realized by the 4% Real Estate Transfer Tax shall be placed in a fund to be used to retire the Town of Ophir's water line debt. If an amount in excess of the amount needed to satisfy the 1985 payment is collected, the General Assembly may authorize the Town Treasurer to spend those funds for specifically designated purposes.
3. All horse use fees shall be used to purchase needed supplies for Town Hall.
4. Revenue Sharing Funds shall be appropriated by the General Assembly for specific projects befitting the Town of Ophir
5. Rental income shall be used as the General Assembly deems necessary.
6. Income from any other sources shall be appropriated as necessary, by resolution or ordinance.
