

TOWN OF OPHIR, COLORADO ORDINANCE NO. 2021-4

AN ORDINANCE TO APPROVE AN AGREEMENT WITH BEE HAPPY LANDS FOR 2021 ORGANIC INTEGRATED WEED MANAGEMENT FOR TOWN OWNED PROPERTY.

WHEREAS, Town of Ophir has need for contracted organic weed management service; and to include, but not limited to, management of toad flax, oxeye daisies, non-native thistles, non-native mustards, scentless chamomile, and white top; and

WHEREAS, Town of Ophir shall utilize 2021 budget funds for maintenance:

- \$8,034.26 Open Space Weed Control
- \$2,000 GOCO Parks & Recreation Weed Management; and

WHEREAS, Town of Ophir has solicited and received pricing options from qualified contractors; and

WHEREAS, Bee Happy Lands provided the most qualified options compatible with Town of Ophir goals and budget, and

WHEREAS, Bee Happy Lands 2020 proposal shall continue to 2021 with no changes.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE TOWN OF OPHIR, COLORADO that:

SECTION 1. The Town Mayor, Town Manager and Town Clerk are hereby authorized and directed to execute an <u>Organic Integrated Weed Management</u> contract with Bee Happy Lands. Mayor and Manager may post-approve non-substantive changes.

SECTION 2. CONTRACT RATES. The following shall be the contracted rates: Two Weed Mitigation Sessions (spring and fall; inclusive of June and mid-August) for 3 days for 2020 = \$9,724.

SECTION 3. The Contract may be annually renewed, and Contract Rates may be modified, upon motion and vote by the General Assembly, subject to annual appropriations.

SECTION 4. PUBLICATION. After final adoption, notice of passage shall be published in the manner prescribed by the Town Charter.

SECTION 5. SEVERABILITY. If any one or more sections or parts of this Ordinance is adjudged unenforceable or invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, such judgment shall not affect, impair, or invalidate the remaining provisions of this Ordinance, the intention being that the various provisions herein are severable.

SECTION 6. EFFECTIVE DATE: This Ordinance shall take effect upon publication of notice of passage.

Introduced, Read and Heard at Public Hearing on First Reading by the General Assembly of the Town of Ophir on the 19th day of January 2021.

Approved and Adopted on Second and Final Reading by the General Assembly of the Town of Ophir on the 16th day of February 2021.
